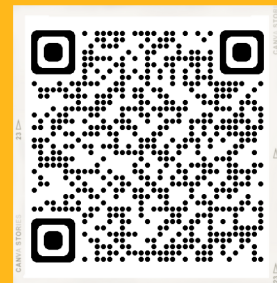
Bring a Friend to Camp!

WHAT IS CAMP?



Community (teamwork, cooperation)
